Rehearsal reminders

There is no rehearsal tomorrow Tuesday 6 February because we are recording the Mealor at the City Hall tonight. Next week we will rehearse the Rossini. Mealor recording tonight Monday 5 February 2018 - chorus start time 7pm sharp

The recording will take place in the City Hall on the evening of Monday 5 February 2018. The chorus will be required from 7pm to 9pm, though if the recording goes well we will be released earlier. The hall has been booked from 5.30pm so chorus members may gather on the choir risers earlier if they wish. However, please be as quiet as you can while waiting to be called for recording.

Please don't forget to sign in using the electronic system we use at rehearsal, which will be situated in the north-east corner of the production corridor as always - new people please ask if you aren't sure where to find this. Please be in your places ready to start recording at 7pm; latecomers may have to wait until a break in the recording before coming on stage.

The seating plan is attached and copies will be available on the choir risers. The plan is very different for a normal one for a concert, especially with regard to the ladies' colouring positions. This is because of the need to get homogeneity of sound across the whole 'colour' spectrum for the microphones. Banding the colours horizontally rather than vertically could cause sight line problems for some people. Please nonetheless keep as close as possible to the indicated seats for colours, making as few adjustments for height problems as is necessary. Even so, Darius may need to move people around to achieve the required balance, so be ready to respond as required.

There is no need to be in concert dress, so no dressing rooms are required. We will record from the concert risers, please use the seats at organ level to leave your bags etc.

Please note that, once recording has commenced, we will need to keep still and very quiet, and follow instructions from the recording engineer and Darius very closely, in order to ensure that the recording can be completed that evening.

We have arranged for the car parking voucher offer to be available from the City Hall Box Office, just as it is on concert days, enabling you to pay £3.50 in the Q Park on Rockingham Street. Park your car, go to the box office and get the voucher, which you'll need when you pay. Please note the voucher is only valid at the Rockingham Street car park.

combine two surveys, therefore there is little choice but to ask both Leeds and Sheffield choir members who wish to sing in the Mahler concerts to complete a new on-line survey.

The details that follow may help members to decide how to respond. The organisers will provide coaches from Leeds/Sheffield to Edinburgh early on the morning of 29 April, and then back to Leeds/Sheffield after the concert, rather than from Edinburgh to Middlesbrough the following day. They will provide coaches from Leeds/Sheffield to Middlesbrough and back again, on Tuesday 1 May. We will book a coach to bring those who stay in Edinburgh back to Leeds/Sheffield on Monday 30th April.

Unfortunately, to add to the difficulties, we are still unsure of the capacity of the newly-built stage at Middlesbrough Town Hall. Depending on the numbers, Darius and David Hill (from Leeds Philharmonic Chorus) may need to select a balanced choir from the revised singing list for the Middlesbrough concert.
