Tomorrow night, Tuesday 27 February, we will rehearse the After Hours Ballroom Concert (ie Brahms & Mendelssohn) in King Edward's Lower School, Darwin Lane, Sheffield, S10 5RG. The school's location on a Google map may be found at the school's website

Please note that the front door is often locked at 7pm because of security requirements, so if you are late please text (preferable) or phone John Spence on 07711 846571; he will come down the corridor to release the door, which will take him a couple of minutes.

The car park is only small and is very busy because of people using the school sports facilities. Parking close by, particularly the closer it gets to 7:00 pm, can be virtually impossible, so do allow sufficient time to find a space. For those travelling by bus the 51 service runs along Sandygate Road and it is a 15 minute walk from Crosspool Post Office along Watt Lane and down Darwin Lane to the school gate. The 120 service runs along Fulwood Road and it is a 13 minute uphill walk from Fulwood Road along Tapton Park Road and Darwin Lane to the school gate.
