# Possible Attendance Score (PAS) and Minimum Attendance Requirement (MAR) for the After Hours Ballroom Concert

As a result of the cancellation of last week's rehearsal the 'score' for that rehearsal has been set at zero. This means that the PAS has reduced from 5 to 4 and the MAR from  $3\frac{1}{2}$  to 3. Here is a typical extract:
