Tickets for the Holy Face concert - update

Thank you for those of you who have been working hard to sell tickets, including those who sent suggestions, all of which are being followed up. Efforts are still needed as sales have slowed again - we have now sold around 340 tickets for the concert. Please help by:

1. Selling tickets to friends and family, either at the City Hall (for centre Circle and front centre stalls) or at rehearsal. £15 or £20 (so you don't pay the booking fee) and free for u-18s. Please try to bring the correct change if you can. £5 reduction for anyone who came to the Xmas or Bach concerts.
2. Sharing the e-flyer via email and/or social media.
3. Sharing posts you see on our public Facebook (FB) page '[Sheffield Philharmonic Chorus](#)' - and inviting your FB friends to like the page. Clicking 'going/attending' on the FB event for this [concert](#) and invite your friends and family to do the same. Sharing any FB posts you see from Halifax Choral Society and Black Dyke Band.
4. Liking and re-tweeting our Twitter posts @SheffPhilChorus and writing your own tweets for us and Sheffield City Hall to re-tweet.

If you're the parent of a child at the Academy or Music Hub, please note that we have sent them a free ticket offer for adults taking their music-making children to the concert. This has been placed on the Academy's parent portal, or ask your child's teacher at the Hub.

The concert is at the City Hall at 3 o'clock in the afternoon.

The on-the-day rehearsal will be from 11.30 to 14.00 in the City Hall. Please be in your seats ready to start rehearsal at 11.30 on the dot; however, the band are rehearsing from 11.00 to 11.30 so please take your seats in silence and as quietly as you can.

Dressing rooms for ladies and gentlemen of both choruses are in the North and South halls, adjacent to the City Hall ballroom, with access available from 10.30am.

The Yorkshire Youth Choir are rehearsing from 10.30 to 11.30 in the ballroom, so please be quiet if you go down to the North and South Hall dressing rooms during this period.

Please sign in using your membership card at the desk on the production corridor which you pass on the way down to the ballroom - please ask if you aren't sure where this is. There will be a sheet for those new members who don't have a membership card yet.

There will be a get-together in the ballroom after the concert, to which all performers have been invited; drinks and nibbles will be available, and the bar will be open.

The chorus user name is the same for every member, it's the word *member* and the password is *dariu5*. These are for chorus members only so please don't share them. However, urgent messages such as rehearsal venue changes are always listed above the log-in box so members can read the important part without logging in.

The Members Area of the website lists all the information included in the update, eg rehearsal details, rehearsal notes and links to recordings, concert and re-audition arrangements, as well as dates for the following season, our official stage procedure, Darius' rehearsal schedule, how to look after your voice etc.

The website is available at <http://sheffieldphil.org> or via a Google search. If taken to an error page it is likely that your computer or laptop has stored the old website in its memory (cache) and you should clear it by pressing REFRESH, or F5 on your PC keyboard. Alternatively it may be that your router needs re-setting; try turning it off for 10 minutes before switching it on again. If none of this works please contact Anne Adams in the first instance, and she will inform the webmasters Matthew Morgan and Bill Best.
