It costs just over £31 from <u>Ackerman Music</u> or <u>Presto Music</u> (very rapid turn-around apparently) or a little bit less <u>from Forewoods Forescore</u> or you might be able to get a good second-hand copy from eBay or Amazon (use the <u>SPC Amazon Smile page</u> link to make a bit of money for the Chorus).
