Next rehearsal Tuesday 15 February 2022 at St Marie' cathedral, Sheffield

Our next rehearsal will be on Tue 15 February 2022, at St Marie's Catholic Cathedral, Norfolk Row, Sheffield, S1 2JB at 7pm. This is just for one week, because KES is no longer available during school holidays. Please note that there is no dedicated parking at St Marie's, but there are plenty of city centre car parks nearby. The cathedral is close to transport hubs; for further details see https://stmariecathedral.org/visit-us/accessibility. There's a mass at 5.30 which will have ended by 6.15 but please be respectful of any parishioners who may not have left. We are booked in from 6.30pm and will be singing in the body of the church. Please sign in at the back of the church and follow instructions about where to sit.

We will continue to take precautions to avoid spreading the Omicron variant – see the 'Covid precautions' list below. The most important measure is to stay away if you have any Covid, flu or cold-like symptoms or if you live with someone who has Covid. Do also feel free to stay away if you still feel nervous about attending.

We will be rehearsing just the Rachmaninov on Tuesday, but you will need your Messiah copies for the next two rehearsals on 22 Feb and 1 March; please check the rehearsal schedule for details, at http://www.dariusbattiwalla.com/currentschedule.pdf; this link is also on the Chorus website at Members Area/Rehearsals along with travel and access details, and links to useful learning and rehearsal resources - user name and password are at the bottom of every update.

Covid precautions

- Do not attend if you have symptoms of Covid, flu or a cold, or have been exposed to a
 person infected with Covid
- Do not attend unless you have had two vaccinations AND a recent negative test
- Please wear face coverings at all times in the building, until just before we sing (unless you're exempt of course)
- Stay distanced as much as you can, including when singing
- Bring your own drinks and don't share them

 Please let us know if you test positive for Covid after the rehearsal; we will continue to alert anyone seated close by

If you develop symptoms, get a PCR test as soon as you can, and isolate if that is also positive. You must also isolate if you don't have symptoms but get a positive lateral flow test result. You can stop isolating when you get two negative lateral flow tests taken on the 5th and 6th day after isolating. The people you live with should take a lateral flow test every day for 7 days, but don't need to isolate unless their test results are positive or they develop symptoms.

If you have been close to someone who has tested positive, take a lateral flow test every day for 7 days - no need to self isolate unless your test results are positive or you develop symptoms.
