Buses from across the city go to the Royal Hallamshire Hospital which is right across the road; these include the H1, 2, 6, 10/10a, 120, 181, 271 and X2. The nearest tram stop is University, which is a 10-minute walk away from the church.

## Reminder - BBC classical music cuts - update (still worth taking action)

As a result of all the protests, the BBC has announced that the BBC Singers will continue while talks take place about alternative funding sources; see <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/entertainment-arts-65063238">https://www.bbc.co.uk/news/entertainment-arts-65063238</a>. This implies the BBC will not fund the singers, and presumably the orchestra cuts are still to go ahead.

If you haven't already had the chance, you might want to consider taking some of the actions using amended wording, given that the announcement, while welcome, does not represent a change of heart on the part of the BBC.
