Rehearsal information

Our next rehearsal will be in the Sports Hall at King Edward's Lower School on Darwin Lane S10 5RG, on Tuesday 26 September 2023; this is because of a parent's evening at the Upper School. There's a Google map on the school's website.

Please walk round the building to the right of the entrance and turn left around the high brick wall into to the back entrance, which takes you directly into the Sports Hall. Please leave via the same route at the end.

The Lower School is well used for sports activities which unfortunately makes parking difficult; you may need to park some distance away, so do allow extra time. For those travelling by bus the 51 and 120 set down about 15 mins walk from the school. For further information see the Travel South Yorkshire website.

Darius is still in Ghent to play the organ for the world premiere of James Wood's *Apokalypsis*, so our rehearsal will again be taken by David Lawrence. We'll be rehearsing the second part of Rachel's lovely *Sheffield Nocturne*.
