Rehearsal information

Our next rehearsal will be at King Edward VII Upper School on Tuesday 17 October 2023. We will be rehearsing for the concert at St Mark's on 28 October.

The code we have been given to open the pedestrian gates is 1786. Please remember that we need to have vacated the premises – including the car park - by 9.15 in order to avoid being locked in (staff safety measure). The school will relax the 9.15 gate lock when we have extended rehearsals or post-rehearsal auditions.

Please note that, as Darius announced last week, to secure a place at the recording session with Black Dyke Band on Monday 20 November, members will need to have attended ALL THREE of the rehearsals prior to the recording.

Darius will not be issuing a rehearsal schedule for this term, as it is a simple case of rehearsing for the event that follows with no mixing.
