The next rehearsal is on Tuesday 5 June at Birkdale School (map at [Members Area / Rehearsals](#)).

We will rehearse the Mozart which the BBC will record. They will also record members entering the building and chatting, so be aware your conversation may be recorded. Check that mobile phones are switched off or muted. Normal rehearsal procedure - watch like a hawk and follow instructions from Darius.
