Reminder - Book about SPC's World Tour in 1911

Newer members may not know that in 1911 Sheffield Musical Union, the choir that became SPC, went on a remarkable world tour with a number of other Yorkshire choirs, covering 34,000 miles and giving 134 concerts in Canada, The United States, Fiji, Australia, New Zealand, Tasmania and South Africa. This unique event is documented in a book by Christopher Wiltshire using letters written by young soprano May Midgley to her family. The book '**12 Oak Avenue – the letters of May Midgely 1911**' was [featured in the Yorkshire Post on 28 July 2018](#) and in the [Sheffield Telegraph in May 2019](#).
