# Rehearsal venue from 07 January 2025

We will be moving to St Andrew's on Psalter Lane from 07 January 2025, for a number of reasons including

- Birkdale reserving the right to cancel our Tuesday hire at short notice for school events; although the church can also do this it is very unlikely that it will do so.
- News that Birkdale will be using the hall for a craft session every Tue afternoon from February onwards and won't have time to clear the tables, leaving far less space for us
- Less than satisfactory accessibility arrangements with little prospect of change, despite repeated efforts on our part.
- Extreme cold during the winter months, which affects us all but especially Rachel on the piano and all three professionals during cold-weather auditions; the issue can't easily be solved as the hire agreement forbids us from using supplementary heaters even when the school doesn't have the heating on at all. The church has under-floor heating which is very efficient and will always be deployed when it's cold.
- Occasional but serious issues with a repeating alarm which the school appears unable to solve.
- Lack of a caretaker out of (and sometimes within) term-time, leading to issues with locked doors and quite serious security responsibilities for SPC; St Andrew's church caretaker Linnea lives next door.

St Andrew's will be a little more expensive, most of which is down to the cost of the under-floor heating and hire of the piano, which belongs to and is maintained by the Sheffield Music Academy. However, Darius and the committee believe the extra cost is worth it to solve the issues listed. The chairs are usually set out in a curve, and we will likely use that arrangement to aid listening between voice parts, with the piano at front left rather than front right. Accessibility is good, including to an extra room for Georgina's workshops and Maggie's training sessions. Darius and Rachel both like the new venue and are in favour of the move.
