Individual log-ins for members' area of the Phil website

Because members have been having problems being locked out of the members' area of our website, we have decided to create individual log-ins. This means you will each have your own username and password. If you forget your password you will be able to reset it yourself.

Your username is in this format: FirstnameLastname. You should have received an email containing your username and 2 links, from matthew@sheffieldphil.org.

The first link is to set your password. It is prefilled with a secure password. It is best to use this password.

The second link takes you to the log-in page. Put in your username as shown in the email, and the password you have generated. (It's best to cut and paste). If prompted to 'save login credentials' or similar, this is a good idea, so it will be prefilled next time and you don't have to remember a difficult password.
